How does Smokebusters work?

Schedule a Tuesday evening appointment for firefighters to come to your home.

- They'll help you develop your family's fire escape plan and test your smoke and carbon monoxide detectors,
- They will also help you identify hidden hazards in your home.

How long does a visit take? program cost?

the firefighters, but generally the average stay is about thirty minutes.

What does the program cost?

Smoke busters is free of charge.

What if our detectors are not working?

We ask that you purchase one 9-volt battery for each smoke and carbon monoxide detector that you have.

Plymouth's Batteries Plus Store, 4404 Nathan Lane, provides 9-volt lithium batteries to Smokebuster participants at a discounted price. These batteries have an 8-10 year shelf life.

This is an exceptional value that will help keep your family safe.

Test your smoke detectors monthly and replace their batteries once a year.
